Halloween turns out to be a visitor magnet -Almost 40.000 guests: Record at Europa-Park

From November 8th until November 26th, Europa-Park will close its doors in order to decorate the park for the "magical Winter Weeks?, which will start on November 27th with the 3rd Santa Claus Gathering.
